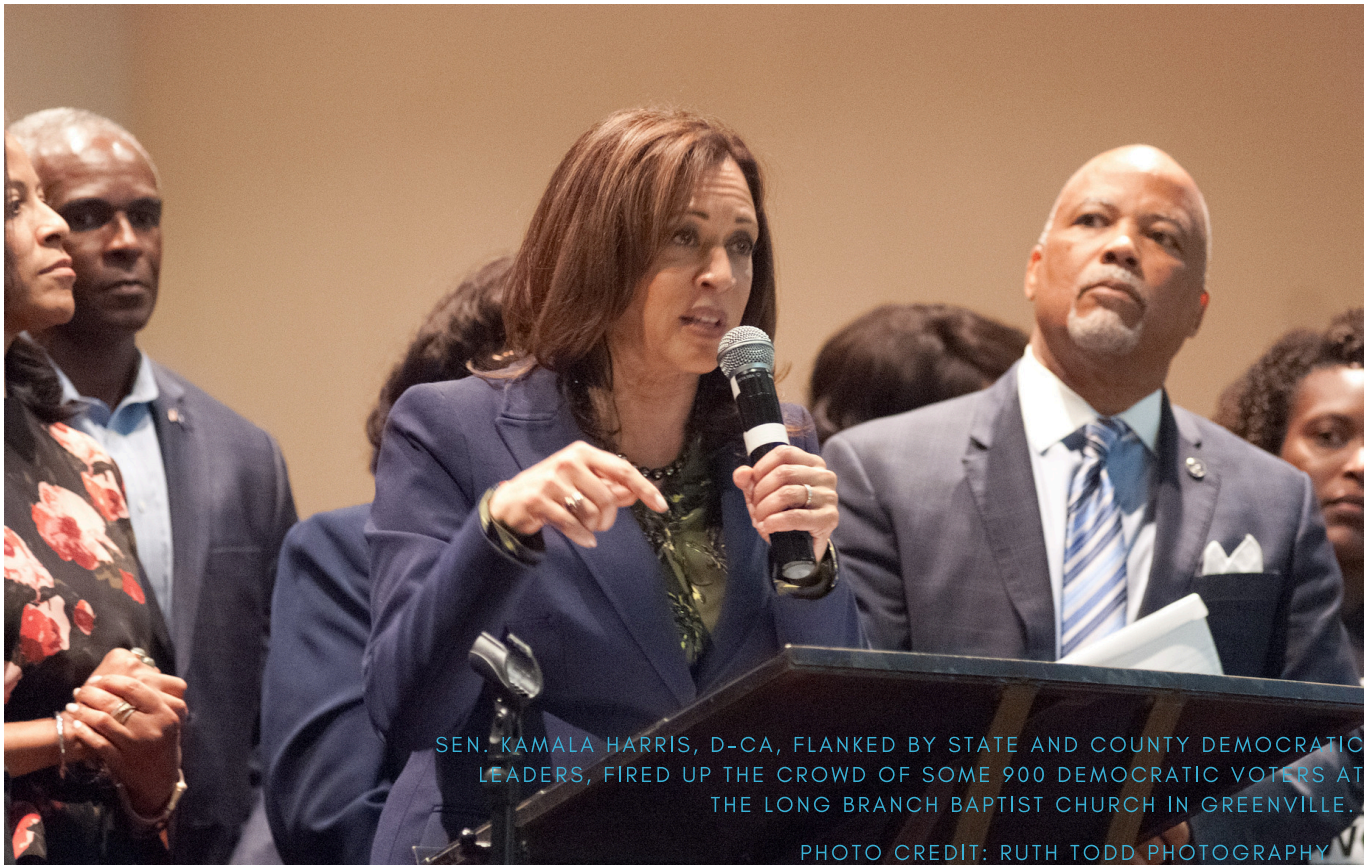

This election is in your hands.

A recent Pew Research Center survey of the 2016 presidential election concluded: "Those who didn't vote are as responsible for the outcome of the election as those who did. . . Among groups that preferred Clinton, they were about 50 percent more likely to be a bigger part of the nonvoting community." [Bump, P. (2018, 9 August). New data makes it clear: Nonvoters handed Trump the presidency. Washington Post] Thirty percent of eligible voters did not vote – that's higher than the percentage who voted either for Hillary or for Donald Trump.

Let's not have that be our story this year. The Democratic Party field operation is focused on connecting with folks who have voted for Democrats in the past but haven't been consistent voters. We're having very productive conversations with them through phone banks and canvasses. The candidates themselves are working diligently and with great passion to engage voters throughout their districts and show them that Democratic policies make their interests and welfare a priority.

Let's not wake up on November 7 and say, "I could have, I should have." Let's get out the vote instead!

South Carolina ETV and the Post and Courier are co-hosting two gubernatorial debates between James Smith and Henry McMaster. The second and final debate will be here in Greenville at Greenville Technical College Technical Resource Center Auditorium in Greenville on Thursday, October 25. The hour-long debates begin at 7 p.m. and are carried live statewide on SCETV stations, South Carolina Public Radio, and online at scetv.org.

The candidates for lieutenant governor, Rep. Mandy Powers Norrell and Pamela Evette, will debate in the studio at SCETV on Monday, October 29 starting at 7 p.m. This is the first year that lieutenant governor candidates are running on the same ticket as the governor.
